R2 CENTERING TARGET JIG

Overview:

The current R2 centering target jig (from the Rivian Target Placement System) does not stay in place on the front fascia. Originally, the intention was for the silicone friction material to hold the jig in place. We are aware that this method is no longer suitable to hold the jig during calibrations. The Service Tool Engineering team is working on a updated design that will be shared at a future date. For now, please follow the directions in this document to properly secure the jig during use.

Instructions:

- Use masking tape to hold the jig in place.
- Note the camera cutout area for proper alignment of the tool.
 - The round notch should sit directly over the camera lens.
