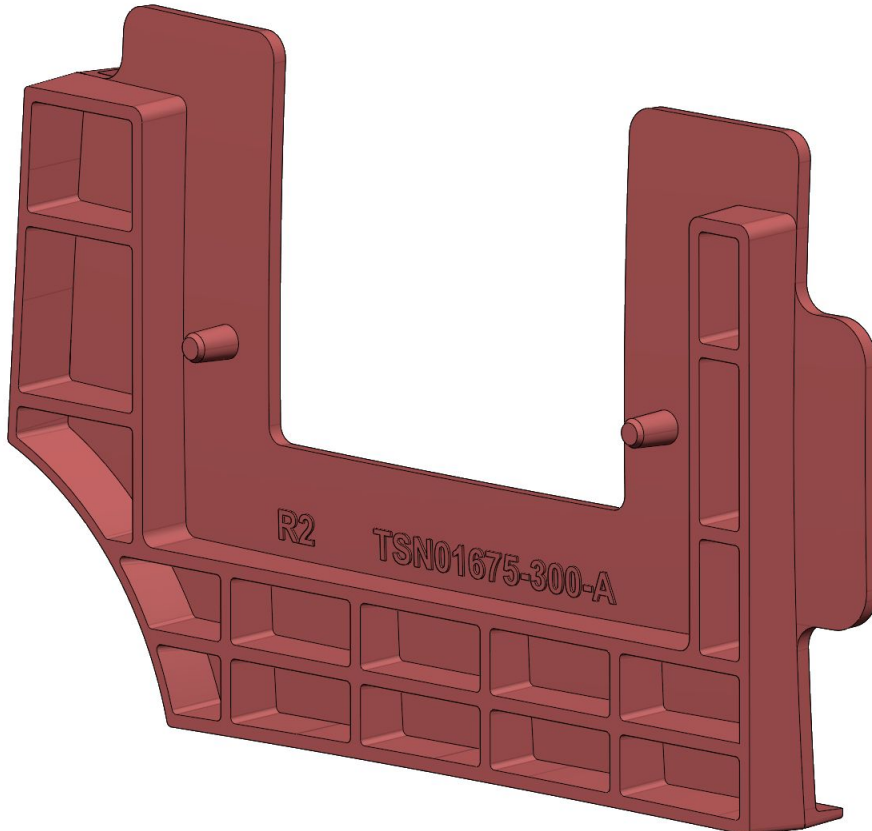

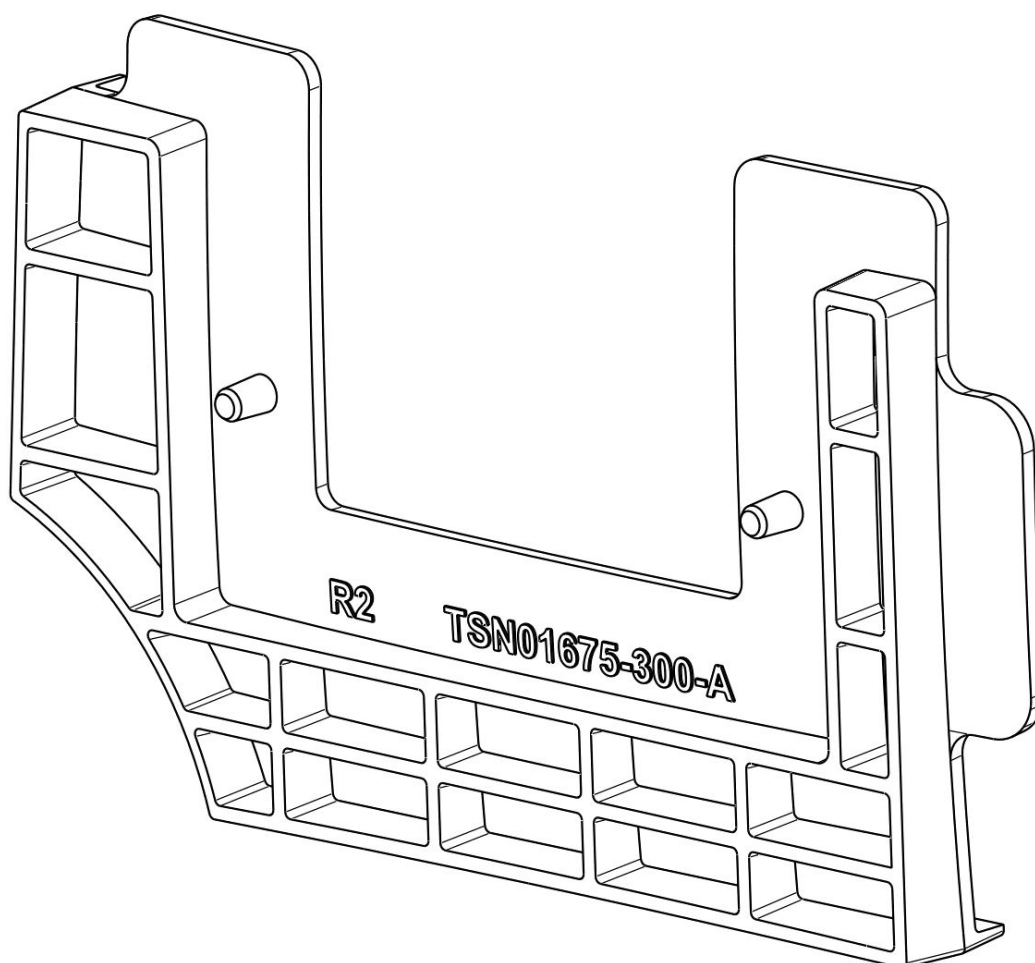

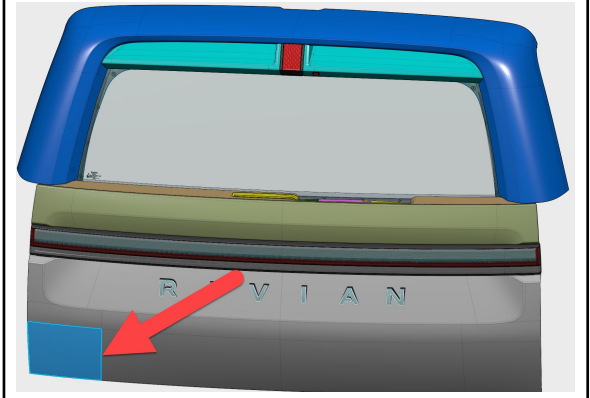

INITIAL SETUP





Clean the badge jig and the application area using isopropyl alcohol wipes or rubbing alcohol on a clean cloth.

Allow the surface to fully dry before installing badge.



TOOL USE INSTRUCTION

<p>1</p>	<p>Using masking tape, adhere the badge jig to the lower right hand corner of the tailgate.</p> <p>Ensure the edges of the jig fully contact the side and bottom edges of the tail gate.</p>	
<p>2</p>	<p>Remove the backer from the badge and carefully place it into the locating space using the pins and alignment holes in the film/foam carrier as a guide.</p>	
<p>3</p>	<p>Apply pressure with a roller for 30 seconds to ensure badge is fully attached.</p>	



BASIC MAINTENANCE GUIDE

TASK	FREQUENCY
Ensure the badge jig is clean and free of oils and debris that may damage paint	Before Each Use
Visually inspect badge jig for wear or damage	Before Each Use
Return badge jig to the special tools area. Do not place anything on the jig to prevent deformation.	After Each Use



TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
Badge jig does not fit the contours of the vehicle.	Make sure you are using the badge jig designated for the correct vehicle and there is no warpage or damage to the jig.
Badge jig does not fit	Make sure there is no debris or damage on the the jig.
